- Class introductions
- Attend "A Creative Life: Sarah Aslakson gallery exhibit opening reception and gallery talk

Week 2:

Thursday, June 27, 2019 at 4:00-6:00 pm

- Introduction to class
- Discussion of abstraction vs realism/Handouts
- Slide show of examples of abstract and realistic art
- Gesso - 2 canvases per student
- Assignment: Find a subject matter, a photograph, an object that you could express in both a realistic style and an abstracted style in painting. Think about how you could express your subject matter, make sketches of your ideas.

Week 3:

Thursday, July 11, 2019 at 4:00-6:00 pm

- Planning of project: pick one subject matter that is expressed in both realism and abstraction painting
- Begin 2 paintings

Week 4:

Thursday, July 18, 2019 at 4:00-6:00 pm

- Continue to paint abstract and realistic painting

Week 5:

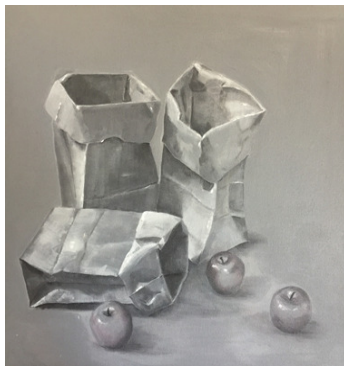
Thursday, July 25, 2019 at 4:00-6:00 pm

- Finish paintings
- Group discussion and critiques

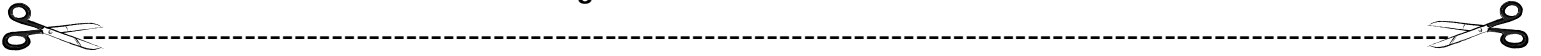
