

# 2019 Wisconsin Regional Arts Program Competition & Exhibit

1940 – 2019/Celebrating Over 75 Years

## Monroe WRAP Competition Entry Guidelines:

The program is open to NONPROFESSIONAL artists and crafts persons living in Wisconsin or neighboring states. Each artist determines for themselves if they are nonprofessional. Professional means supporting yourself solely with your art. Artists ages 14 and older are eligible to enter. The entry fee is \$30.

1. All work must be ORIGINAL in concept and design. It must have been done by the person signing it. Copies of other artwork, copyrighted photographs, or patterns cannot be accepted. No decorated kits are acceptable. Paintings made as copies during a teacher's demonstration are not eligible. Work must have been completed within the last two years (April 2017). In some workshops, you may enter up to three works; the Monroe WRAP workshop allows only two (2) works due to space limitations.

2. Media accepted for exhibit include PAINTING: Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, but no giclee reproductions of paintings; GRAPHICS: Drawing, Prints, Pastel; SCULPTURE: Any Material, Mixed-Media; CRAFTS: Clay, Wood, Metal, Fiber, Paper; PHOTOGRAPHY: Black and White, Color, Digital (print or photograph).

3. All paintings, graphics, and photographs must be dry, framed, and ready to hang (with wire attached from side to side on the back). No tension devices will be accepted in place of frames (they break). Plastic frames are discouraged for the same reason. Any wall-hung sculpture or crafts must be ready with necessary hanging devices.

Wall-hung art may not exceed 20 pounds. If so, permission from the exhibit location gallery director must be made prior to the delivery of the artwork.



4. UW-MADISON AND THE WORKSHOP SPONSORS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGES OR LOSS OF YOUR WORK. You must provide your own insurance if desired. You may enter as many workshops as you like. On the day your artwork is due, bring your work to the exhibit location on the specified days/times. Be sure to attach an identification label to each piece. The entry fee (\$30) covers the exhibit of artwork and participation in the Artist Workshop day. Guests may attend the Artist Workshop for \$5.00 per person. All artwork must be removed from the location at the conclusion of the Artist Workshop day.

5. Entry in WRAP competitions must be completed ONLINE. If you do not have online access, download the Monroe entry form and mail (along with your check payable to Monroe Arts Center, PO Box 472, Monroe, WI 53566). Monroe Arts Center WRAP dates below:

Artwork Delivered ONLY ON: Friday and Saturday - April 5 or April 6, 2019 from 10:00 am - 5:00 pm

Artist Workshop Day: Saturday, April 27, 2019 from 9:30 am – 12:00 pm

Monroe Exhibition Dates: April 11, 2019 – April 27, 2019

Opening Reception: Thursday, April 11, 2019 from 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm
