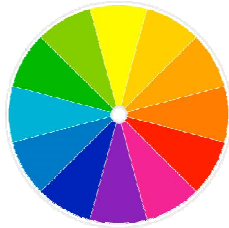

2019 Winter Sessions

Week 1 - January 14, 2019

Shades of a Winter Wonderland

In this class we will be bringing the beauty of our winter landscapes to life using monochromatic backgrounds or the different shades of one color. We will explore how the different values of one color can be used to create extraordinary works of art.



We will be exploring complimentary colors and balancing opposites in this class. Using the color wheel, we will blend, mix, and use Color Theory to create a unique project using color mixing and collage.

Begin With A Brushstroke

Inspired by the work of Paul Cezanne, we will use oil pastels to create still life art works while searching for the shape and form of each object in our work and begin to understand how the forms can relate to each other in a work of art.



WEEK 4 – February 4, 2019

When Art Imitates Life

Claes Oldenburg said, “Art is a technique of communication. The image is the most complete technique of all communication.” In this class while we celebrate the birthday of this American sculptor, we will also take a look at his work and try our hand at creating our own Claes Oldenburg inspired art.

WEEK 5 - February 11, 2019

We Heart Art!

Paper is the most widely used material in arts and crafts. In this class we will explore paper as an artistic medium, while considering the art principle of balance. We will use this background to create paper mosaic heart projects that say “Happy Valentine’s Day!”



WEEK 6 - February 18, 2019

Pleasing Pottery Projects!

Let’s play with clay! We will take time to explore the Mata Ortiz pottery work in the gallery and then try our hand at creating our own clay projects.
