

Nuno Felt Scarf Class – Supply List

SUPPLY LIST:

The instructor will supply the following:

Silk scarf, Merino wool, luxury fibers for embellishment, various felting tools, and supplies including bubble wrap and pool noodles.

EACH STUDENT SHOULD BRING THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES:

- 2 pieces of thin plastic, such as plastic dropcloth – approx. 24-30” wide and 7-8 ft. long
- 1 length of nylon netting or tulle or sheer polyester curtain – approximately the same dimensions as the plastic. (You can overlap two lengths if necessary to get the total length.)
- Plastic dishpan or small bucket
- Clean plastic bag to take wet scarf & towels home.
- Squirt bottle or spray bottle, minimum 16 oz. capacity. If you have a Ball Brause, bring that instead. This is a great tool for wet felting. The bulb holds water and is used to take up hot water from a bowl or tub and gently sprinkle it on to your fibers without disturbing the design. (See image below)
- Small bottle of Dawn dishwashing liquid (this brand recommended as it works the best for this project)
- Sponge
- Scissors
- Three to four old bath towels
- Pen and paper to take notes
- Your own lunch and beverage
- Optional Items: Nylon body scrubby; waterproof apron; set of four bed risers

Note: This is a physically demanding class which requires some upper body strength and the ability to stand for long periods. Wear comfortable shoes and clothes that can get wet. Participants may bring a set of bed risers (that are placed under the legs of a bed to raise it higher off the floor) which can be used to raise your work table and lessen strain on your back.
