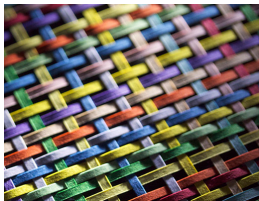
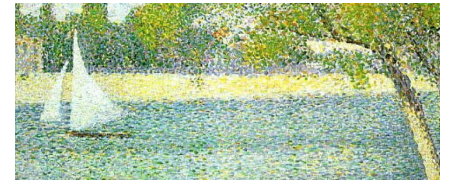
WEEK 4 – November 26, 2018
